

Dow Jones U.S. Economic Stimulus IndexSM

Fact Sheet

Stated Objective

The Dow Jones U.S. Economic Stimulus IndexSM measures 50 leading U.S. companies expected to benefit from the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

Key Features

- Eligible for the index are U.S. companies in six economic industries determined by Dow Jones Indexes to map to the investments targeted by the stimulus package: Alternative Energy, Construction & Materials, Energy Grid, Environment, Technology and Telecommunications/Internet.
- Within these categories, stocks are selected for the index based on float-adjusted market capitalization, subject to liquidity screens. The number of companies selected from each industry is proportionate to the expected spending in that area, subject to a five-stock minimum.
