## Stated Objective

To measure the stock performance of U.S. companies in the Industrials sector.

## Key Features

- The index represents the Industrials Industry as defined by the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB).
- The index is one of ten indexes that together make up the Dow Jones U.S. Index<sup>SM</sup>, which represents approximately 95% of U.S. market capitalization.
