

# Methodology

## Introduction

The Dow Jones Islamic Market Turkey Index<sup>SM</sup> measures the stock performance of companies traded in Turkey that pass screens for compliance with Islamic principles.

## Index Universe

The index universe is defined as all stocks in the Dow Jones Emerging Europe Index<sup>SM</sup> that are traded on the Istanbul Stock Exchange. The Dow Jones Emerging Europe Index<sup>SM</sup> covers approximately 95% of the float-adjusted market capitalization of the region that currently includes Cyprus, the Czech Republic, Estonia, Hungary, Israel, Latvia, Lithuania, Malta, Poland, Russia, Slovenia, Slovakia and Turkey. Preferred stocks are excluded from the selection universe.

## Stock Selection

Stocks in the index universe are screened based on industry type and financial ratios. Stocks that pass all of the screens are added to the index.

### Industry Screens

Excluded are companies that represent any of the following lines of business:

- Alcohol
- Tobacco
- Pork-related products
- Financial services
- Defense/weapons
- Entertainment

### Financial Ratio Screens

Excluded are companies for which any of the following ratios are 33% or more:

- Total debt divided by trailing 12-month average market capitalization
- The sum of a company's cash and interest-bearing securities divided by trailing 12-month average market capitalization
- Accounts receivables divided by trailing 12-month average market capitalization

## Review Frequency

The index is reviewed quarterly, in March, June, September and December.

## Weighting

The index is weighted by float-adjusted market capitalization.
